Hike #1

Starting time: 11 a.m.

Meeting place: Nature Center

Description: 3-mile easy hike with opportunity to observe all types of wildlife, including many species of

birds. Limited to 40 people.

Hike #2

Starting time: 11 a.m. Meeting place: Boat ramp

Description: 3-mile moderate snowshoe hike from the boat ramp to Rocky Mountain Bird Observatory.

Limited to 25 people.

Barr Lake's staff encourages you to start the New Year by enjoying the outdoors and seeing the eagles. Spotting scopes will be available for visitors to use on the hikes. There will also be 15 pairs of loaner snowshoes available if there is snow.
