

River Watch 2015 Volunteer Training Registration

River Watch trainings provide an opportunity for your organization to become volunteer water quality monitors in Colorado. Our training registration is based on a first come, first served basis. The cost of the training will cover food and lodging during the training at Camp Cedaredge. Lodging is dorm style with shared facilities, meals are cafeteria style.

New organizations seeking to be a part of River Watch of Colorado are requested to pay a one-time \$220 fee. The fee will cover the cost of one participant to attend this training and to help subsidize the cost of the equipment you will receive (valued at over \$1900), as well as curriculum and program support. All other participants from new or existing groups are expected to pay for each individual's training cost of \$110 per person. Meals and lodging are included in the \$110. The deadline to register for this event is July 1, 2015. Registration after this date will be \$250 per new group and \$140 per additional person or returning volunteer.
